The present volume comprises the second and last part of the correspondence of Leonhard Euler with Daniel, James II, and James III Bernoulli. For the first part see [\[Zbl 1360.01049\]](#).

The volume starts with the second part of Chapter IV containing the correspondence between Leonhard Euler and the Bernoullis. While the correspondence of the time period 1726–1743 was included in the first volume this second volume starts with the letters from 1744 to 1772.

Chapter V comprises the introduction to the correspondence between John Albrecht Euler and Daniel Bernoulli and starts with a biography of Euler's first son. The actual correspondence can be found in Chapter VI.

The Appendix is Chapter VII and contains the correspondence of Daniel Bernoulli and Leonhard Euler with office-bearers of the Academy St. Petersburg, and the extant parts of the correspondence of Daniel Bernoulli with Euler's last assistance Nicolas Fuss as already mentioned. The Register comprises the final Chapter VIII and contains the bibliography, the personal register, a systematic subject index, and a list of abbreviations.

Again, letters written in Latin, French, or old German are translated to modern German. As in the first volume the letters are thoroughly commented and put in context. Together with Part I the two parts comprise an indispensable source for historians of science and allow a close look into the intellectual activities of the scientists involved.
